RESTORE DAMAGED IMAGES

GIMP gives us some useful tolos to restore images that have been damaged. We are going to see this with an example. Save the image **restaurar.jpg** that will be given to you, and open it with GIMP.



Use the clone tool and/or the healing tool to erase the cracks (grietas) all over the image. The clone tool may also be helpful to rebuild the bars (rejas) over the two men on the upper right corner of the image..

Use the smudge tool and the blur tool to hide the imperfections that the image might have after your restoring process.

Finally, go to menú *Colours > Desaturate* to change the image into grayscale. At the end of the process, you must have something like this:



Save your work as **restaurar2.jpg** in the same folder tan the original.
